Projects designed by Mr. Melburg include the new Redding Civic Center (110,000 s.f.), Monterey Civic Center, the Shasta County Administration Center (110,000 s.f.), the Redding Corporation Yard, the Corporate Headquarters for Sierra Pacific Corporation, the Headquarters Building for Wm. D. Johnson Company, KMS Research Inc. World Headquarters, the Red Bluff Community / Senior Center, and numerous other major office buildings. Current projects include the new \$60 million Temecula Civic / City Centre, a master plan linking the government center with the existing 'Old Town' of Temecula, and the Tehama County Administration Center.

In addition to civic and corporate projects, Mr. Melburg is also well known for designing residences for high profile and celebrity clients.

Mr. Melburg has won a number of awards for design accomplishments, including an A.I.A. Honor Award for the Shasta Enterprises Office Building. He has won more than 20 awards from the City of Redding Urban Design Awards Competitions.
